A long distance path connecting Helsingør and Roskilde

SUPPLIES, FOOD AND DRINK

Roskilde: All kinds of shops,cafés and restaurants

Ågerup: a supermarket - Fakta on the path

Østrup: Min Butik handicrafts, gifts and meat products from the farms Hereford cattle (open Friday to Sunday)

Stenløse: Many different kinds of shops, both cafés and restaurants

Buresø: Small grocery shop and café only open in the summer months Placed at the east end of Buresø lake, close to the bathing jetty

Farum: Many different kinds of shops, both cafés and restaurants

Allerød: Many different kinds of shops, both café´ and restaurants

Karlebo: An Inn close to the church

Fredensborg: Many different kinds of shops, both cafés and restaurants

Mørdrup: Small supermarket about 200m from the station on Mørdrupvej – see the description leaving the path at Mørdrup.

Espergærde: Centre with many different kinds of shops, both cafés and restaurants – see the description leaving the path at Mørdrup.

Helsingør: All kinds of shops, cafés and restaurants.

Along the route there may be other cafés/ice cream parlours that are seasonal. These and a couple of wayside inns change hands frequently so there is no guarantee that they are open or not.
